Narrative:

On August 25, 2016 at a little after midnight, officers from the Essex Police Department went to Logwood Circle, in Essex to investigate a report that a wanted subject was at a residence there. Joshua Brissette, 31 y/o of Winooski was observed at the residence. Brissette ran back into the house and refused to come out. Brissette had several outstanding arrest warrants including warrants for Aggravated Domestic Assault 1st degree and Unlawful Restraint 1st degree. The residence belongs to his Grandmother who is currently out of town.

Essex Police requested and was granted a search warrant to enter the residence. Officers from the Essex Tactical Unit enter the house and subsequently arrested Brissette. Brissette was in the company of Danielle Brissette 31 y/o of Winooski at the time of arrest. She was not harmed during the incident.

Joshua Brissette was lodged pursuant to the arrest warrants for lack of \$5000.00 Bail.

Essex Police was assisted during the incident by South Burlington Police k-9 unit, Vermont State Police, Williston Police and Richmond Police.
