### **Important Notes on Requesting Records from the Essex Police Department**

1. Not all Police records are public records. We are governed by the Vermont Public Records Law and Essex Police Department records policies and procedures. Please review the Vermont Public Records law [HERE](#) or at 1 V.S.A. Chapter 5, section 318 for exemptions allowed by law. In addition there are other State and Federal laws that restrict or prohibit the handling and dispensation of juvenile records as well as other matters.
2. Fees may be assessed pursuant to the Vermont Uniform Fee Schedule which can be found [HERE](#) or at 1 VSA 316(d) of the Vermont Statutes Annotated. (Note – Payment of fees can be required in advance)
3. If the records you requested have been determined to be public records, but are not immediately available for inspection, we will provide you with an estimate of when they will be ready. If determined that the records you requested are exempt from Public Inspection you will also be notified why and you're right to appeal.
