Utilize this **local, STARS** accredited, State of VT **licensed** program option for **quality** afterschool care, with **structured and unstructured** time, a **caring** staff, a separate program for **kindergarteners**, operated by **Essex Junction Recreation and Parks**, at an **inexpensive** price.

This coming school year, the Aspire building at Maple Street Park will be the home for all Hiawatha and Summit Kindergarteners enrolled in Village Kids. Each day, children will be picked up at their classroom door and transported by Village Kids staff, via bus, to Maple Street Park. While at the park, children will enjoy all of the amenities of Maple Street Park, a nutritious snack, and a daily schedule full of Kindergarten-centered programming. Programming for this site will be catered specifically to the unique developmental needs of kindergarteners, allowing them to grow at their own pace and explore their individual interests.
